PRESIDENT'S AWARD

This trophy, donated by Barbara Ullstein, is presented annually to the Essex Garden Club member who receives the most points for the exhibition of horticulture and/or design: flowers, branches, house plants, vegetables, fruits, and fresh or dried floral arrangements. The name of the winning member and year of presentation are engraved on the trophy.



- One point for each exhibit (horticulture or design), i.e. monthly meeting, library flowers and flower shows
- Four points for a first place Federated or GCA Award
- Three points for a second place Federated or GCA Award
- Two points for a third place Federated or GCA Award
- One point for honorable mention Federated or GCA Award
